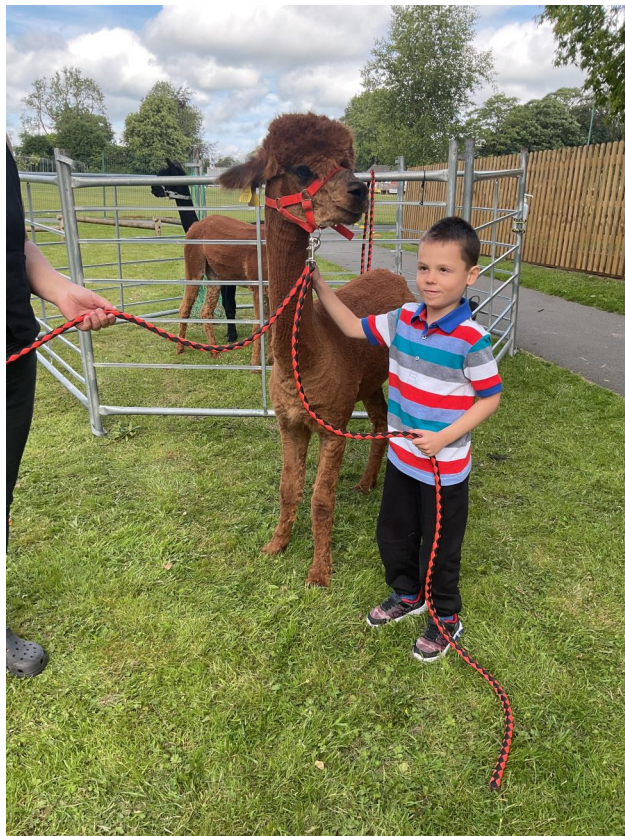

Move-up Days

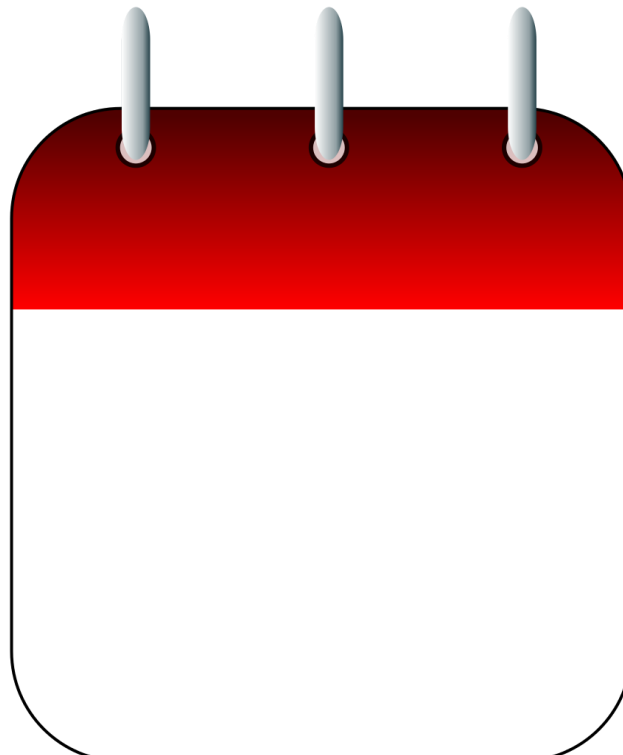


Our next Move-up day events are as follows:

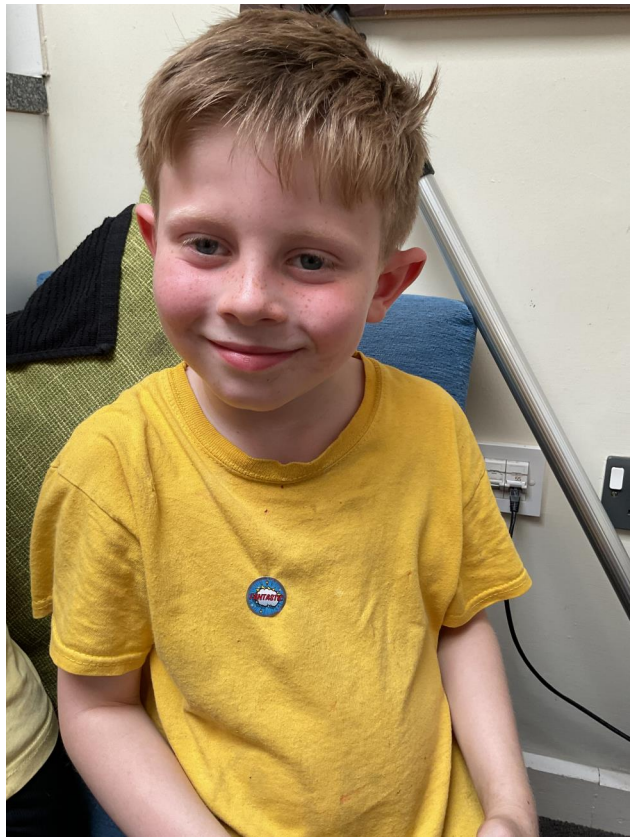
