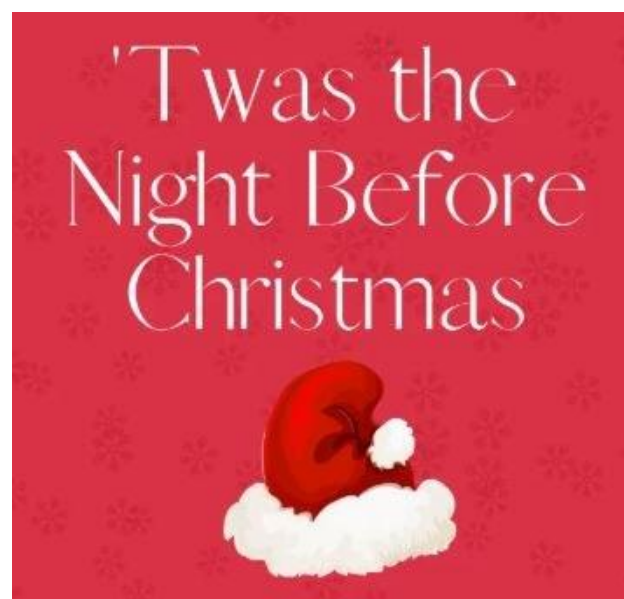
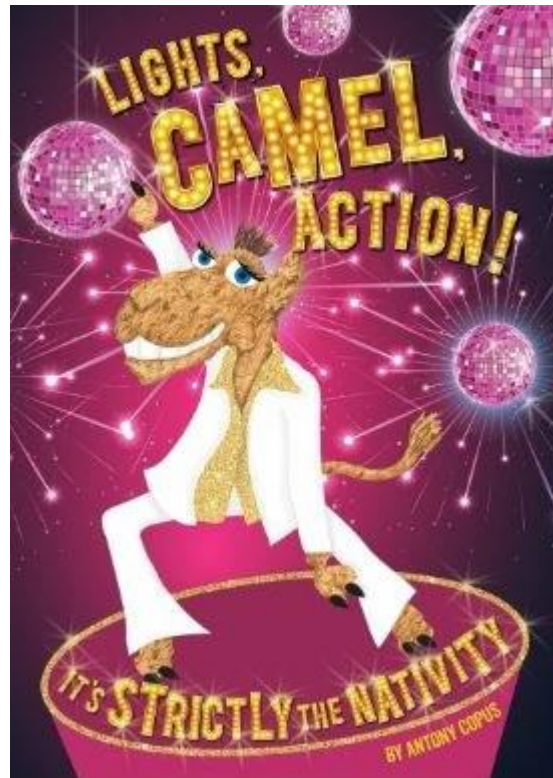

Flu Vaccinations



The NHS team will be at Woore on 12th December to give flu vaccinations to children.

- The vaccine will help protect your child against flu and serious complications such as bronchitis and pneumonia
- Protect you, your family and friends.

- No injection needed.
- The nasal spray is painless and easy to have
- It's better than having flu.
- The nasal spray helps protect against flu, has been given to millions of children worldwide and has an excellent safety record

If you do not wish for your child to receive the live nasal vaccination, they can receive the injectable Inactivated Porcine-free Vaccination – the injectable vaccine is not administered in school. 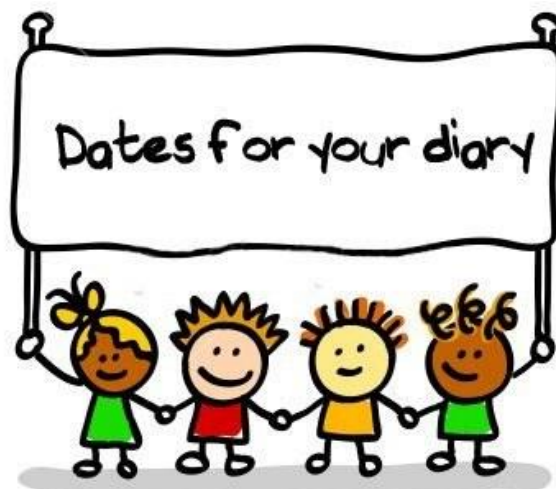
