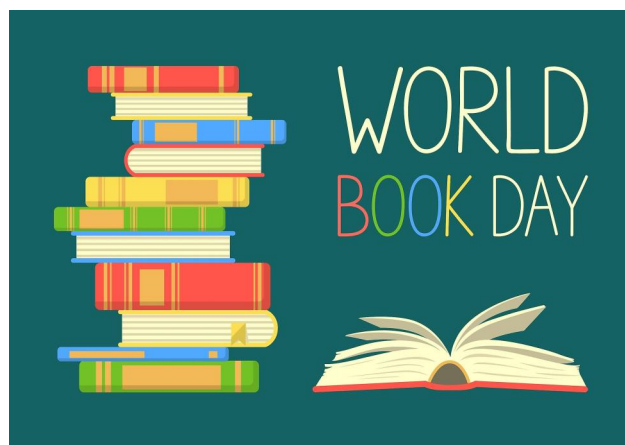
The deadline for work is Friday 15th March.
