



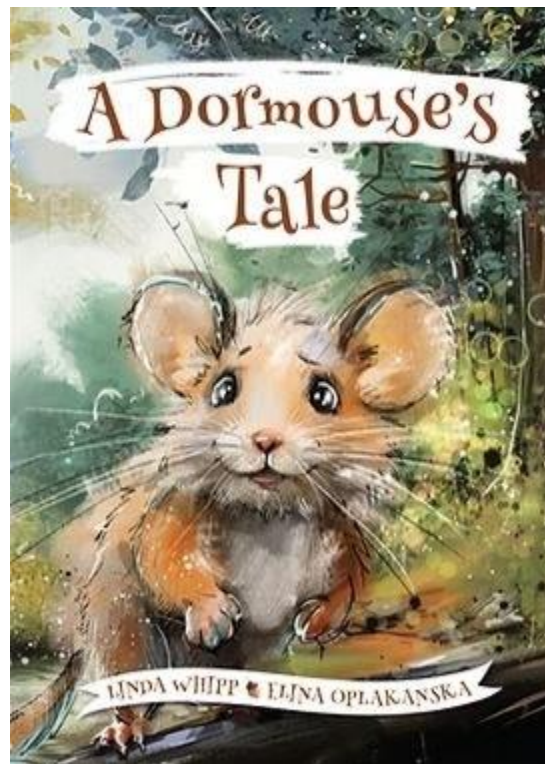

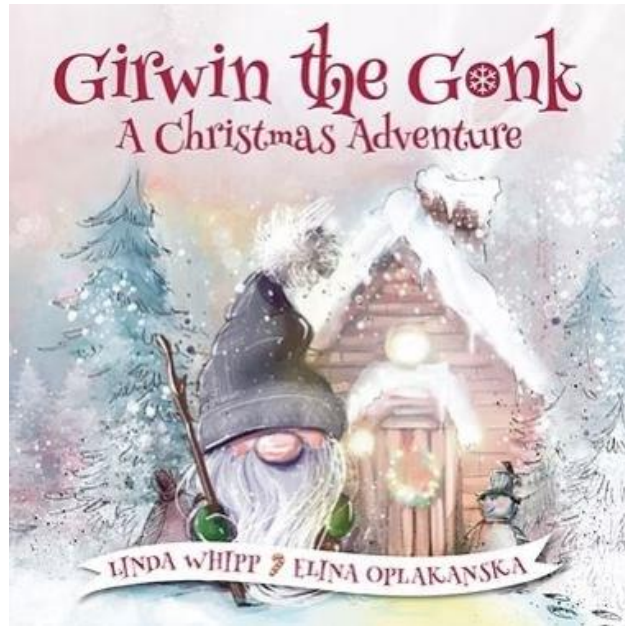

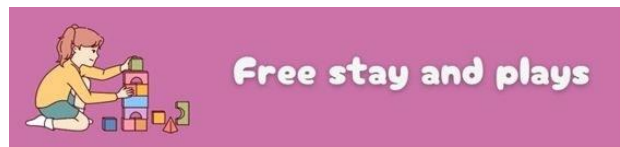
## Woore Art Gallery Event
