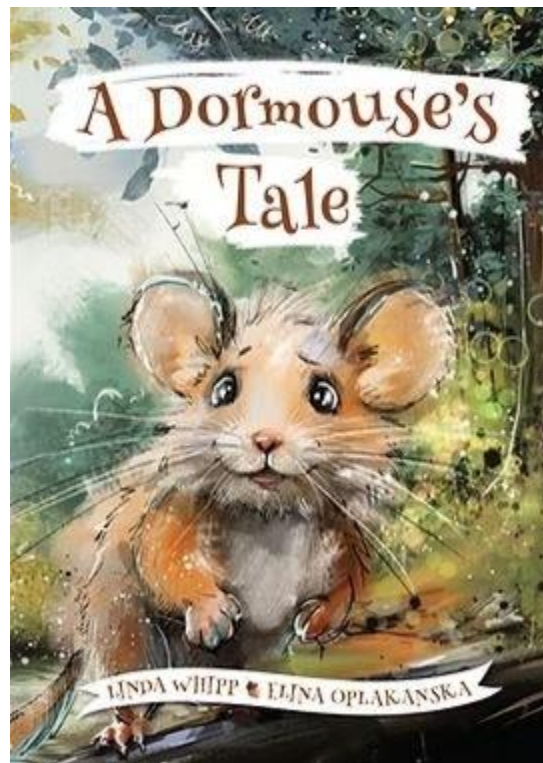
Woore Art Gallery Event

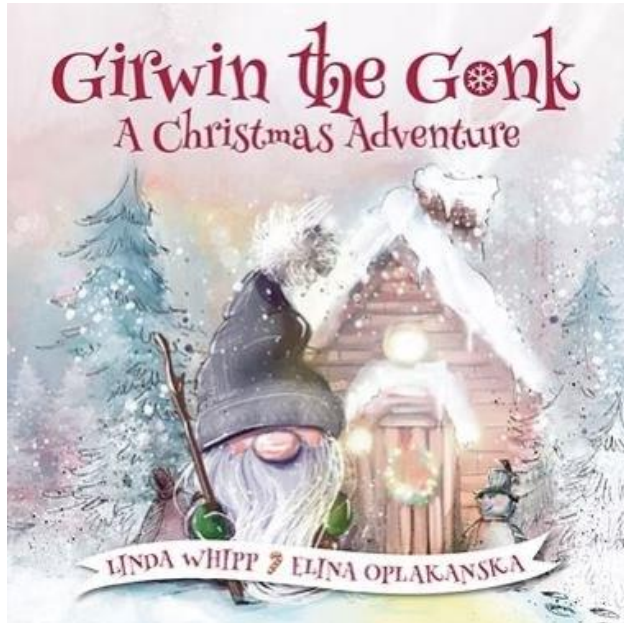


On **Monday 17th March** we will be opening our doors for our very first ‘**Woore Art Gallery**’ event. 🖼️

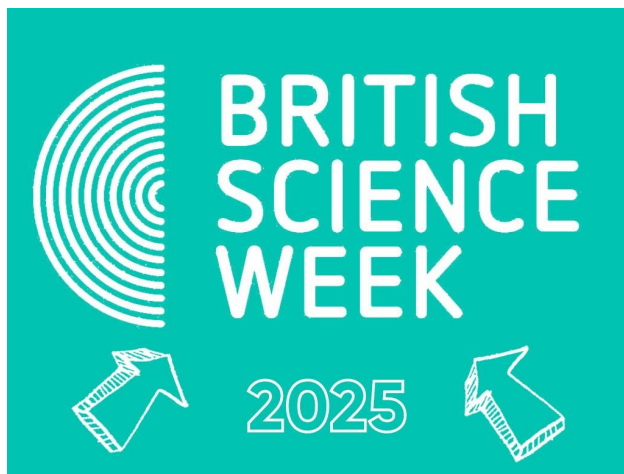
