New Food Policy

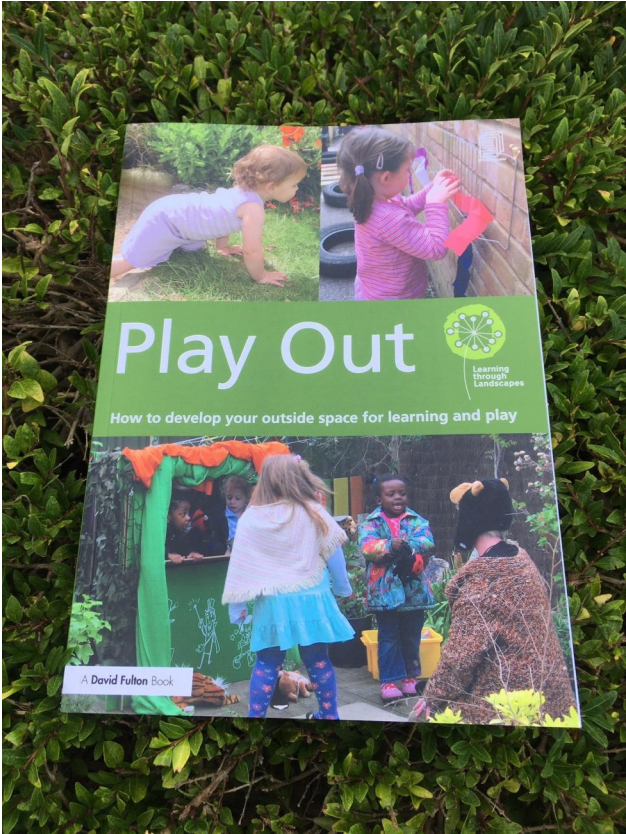


The school governor Health and Safety Committee have recently approved a new school 'Food Policy'. This outlines the recommendations and procedures undertaken by our school to ensure a healthy and balanced diet is followed in order to keep our children healthy. In brief, we request the following from our families when bringing food and drinks to school.

- **Healthy snacks-** are brought to school, such as fruit, vegetables, savour snacks or yoghurt (no chocolate, sugary bars, sweets or crisps)
- **Packed lunches-** Parents and pupils are encouraged to send a healthy packed lunch, including an energy food (e.g. sandwich, pasta or rice salad, crackers) with some body-building food (e.g. lean meat, fish, egg, cheese) and a portion of dairy foods (eg cheese, milk drink, yoghurt) and some fresh fruit or vegetables. Sweets or confectionary are not permitted. Healthy drinks are promoted such as water and milk. No fizzy drinks are permitted.
- **Water Policy-** Parents and carers are asked to provide their child with a clean bottle of water daily; they will be asked not to provide any other drinks for consumption in the classroom. If children arrive without water, children will have access to a clean cup and drinking water throughout the day. Children who forget their own water bottles are provided with water to drink with their lunch. Water is provided for children to drink when they take a school lunch.

Local School Nature Grant







We are delighted to announce that we have been awarded a Local School Nature Grant, thanks to players of the People's Postcode Lottery. Our pupils will be benefitting from a range of equipment including a Play Outdoor book, Circle time Outdoor kit, Weather Kit and Den Building Kit which will be used during curriculum and forest school sessions . In addition staff will receive training to help children learn outdoors. Pupils from the Eco-club played an important role in applying for the grant and selected equipment that they felt would benefit their peers. The children were very pleased with the award, one child said **"The kit will make people enjoy being outside more, and hopefully try and help the environment and stop global warming. The more people enjoy the environment, the more people there will be to fight for it"**, another child responded with **"The children will have fun outside with the adults who will have training on what to do"**, another child said **"Our bums won't get muddy!!"**, one child said **"The weather kit will help because if it gets too hot we can write letters to the local MP and say that we have been noticing the temperatures getting warmer"**. The project is run by Learning through Landscapes and funded by People's Postcode Lottery, Postcode Neighbourhood Trust, Postcode Places Trust, Postcode Society Trust, Postcode Local Trust or Postcode Community Trust all of who which receives funding from players of People's Postcode Lottery."
