Sports Day

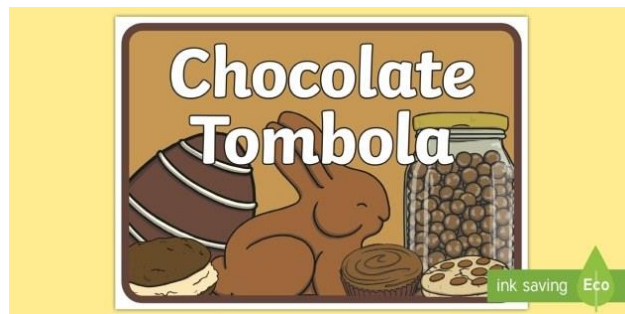

Mini-First Aid Day



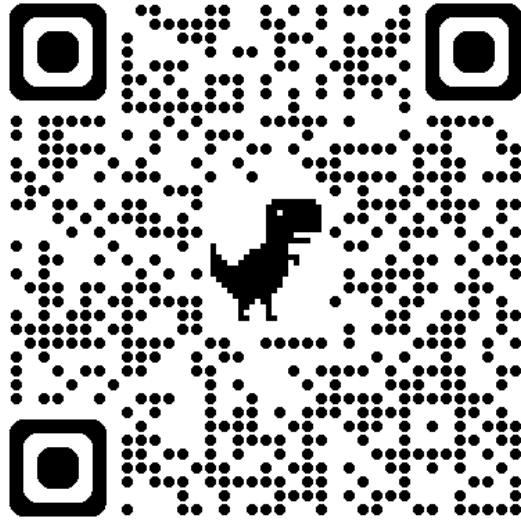
On Friday 28th June the children will be taking part in a 'Mini First Aid' Day. Thank you to the FOWS for funding this important learning opportunity.

Early years first aid

Mini First Aid Early Years classes are for children aged 3-6 and work with the Early Years & Key Stage 1 Curriculum. Children learn about what happens to their bodies if they are hurt and how they would be treated by a grown up.

Mini first aid kids

Mini First Aid Kids is designed for children aged 7-11. Children are starting to be more independent and can understand basic first aid. In this workshop children learn to deal with bumps, burns, breaks and bleeding, carry out CPR and deal with choking. The class is practical, lots of fun and involves lots of activities for the children to enjoy.
