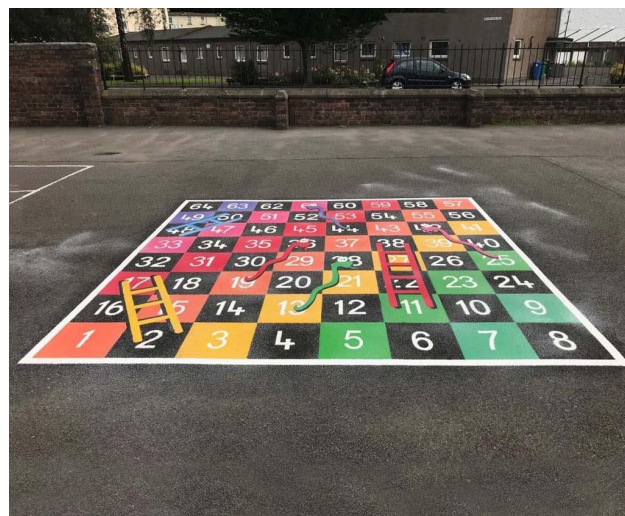

Y6 School Sleepover



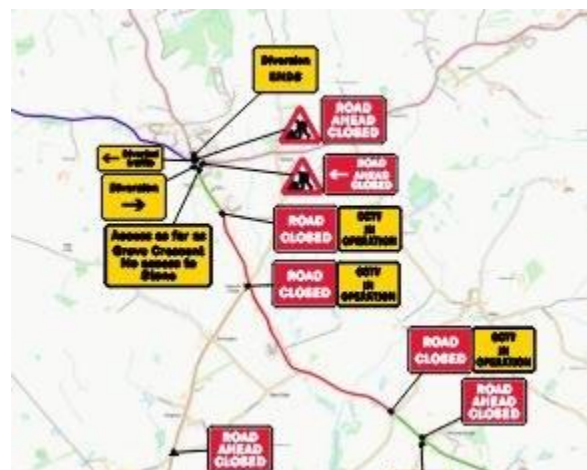

Shropshire Council, are planning to carry out essential carriageway repairs on the A51, London Road, Woore.

These works will be completed with a Road Closure in place **from Friday 5th July to Wednesday 10th July 2024** between the hours of **09:30am – 16:00pm**.

The closure will affect the road through Pipegate up to the Woore sign at Irelands Cross (see attached map).
