School Guinea Pigs-holiday homes





As the summer holidays approach we are looking for a few temporary homes for our school guinea pigs. We have three weeks covered so far but need to ensure that they have a home for the remaining three weeks.

There are three guinea pigs who live inside overnight and go out during the day to graze on the grass. It is possible, however, that they could just be inside or outside rather than both. We can provide all hutches, bedding and food for their stay away. They would need daily fresh fruit and veg on top of this (uncooked)- left over peelings/stalks would be great. We will discuss diet with you.

The guinea pigs need daily cuddles (they are very tame) and to be kept safe, away from other pets such as dogs/cats who might scare/injure them (we really do want to see them back in September).

If you are able to help out for any of the remaining weeks, please inform the office and let us know. Currently, we have one fixed week booked in and two flexible weeks.

Go back in time to the Stone Age and prepare to help your tribe. Visit our special Condober mammoth replica and learn what it can tell us about the Ice Age.

Try using a fire bow and spear thrower and paint with soil pigments in your sacred cave. As a tracker, assess how you will hunt and scavenge using wind direction, footprint trails and more and use stones to make a solar calendar to help you know when it is time to move on.
