Road Works-Pelican to Puffin Crossing Works



We have been advised that road works will be commencing at the traffic lights in Woore on 25 July 2024.

The scheme involves the upgrade of the existing pelican crossing to a puffin crossing and is expected to last for 1 week. Works will be carried out utilising temporary traffic signals and access for businesses/residents will be maintained at all times.

The works are being carried out by Swarco and supervised by WSP on behalf of Shropshire Council.

Every endeavour shall be made to keep disruption to a minimum.

Whilst this may cause some disruption to the community for a short period, latest studies show that puffin crossings are safer than pelican crossings which can only be a good thing for our school community.


